



GUEST GUIDANCE

Secession Golf Club prides itself on providing a simple and traditional golf experience consistent with the traditions of the game. Our staff is here to deliver the friendly, attentive service that makes Secession so special; however, it is the responsibility of members to follow this guidance and ensure their guests do the same. We appreciate your support. Below is guidance from the Club on how guests can best enjoy an exceptional Secession experience.

CADDIES

Secession caddies are an integral part of the Club and play a vital role in providing an exceptional golf experience for members and guests. Caddies are independent contractors, not employees of the Club, and therefore serve members and guests directly. It is important that both caddie and member clearly understand the expectations of this relationship.

The recommended fee per bag is \$140. This amount may be adjusted higher or lower depending on the level of service provided and may be agreed upon by the caddie and the member or guest prior to the round.

Secession is an all-walking golf club. Golf carts are not permitted under any circumstances.

PACE OF PLAY - 3:59

The goal at Secession is for rounds to average 3 hours and 59 minutes or better. The use of double-bag caddies requires players to make small adjustments and concessions to maintain proper pace. Playing ready golf and working effectively with your caddie will ensure a smooth, enjoyable round for all.

NON-GOLFING GUESTS

To protect the quality of the Secession experience, guests visiting the Club solely for food and beverage without playing golf are discouraged. Club facilities are intended for the enjoyment of members and their golfing guests.

PAYMENT AND GRATUITIES

All charges for golf, accommodations, and dining must be posted to the member's account. Guests may use credit cards for Golf Shop merchandise purchases only. Club employees are fairly and appropriately compensated. Additional gratuities for exceptional service are appreciated but not expected.



GUEST GUIDANCE

CELL PHONES AND DIGITAL DEVICES

To fully enjoy the Secession experience, cell phone and digital device use should be kept to a minimum. We recognize that digital devices are a necessary part of modern communication, and therefore members and guests may send and receive texts and emails and access the web in all areas of the Club. However, all devices must remain on silent mode at all times while on Club property.

Voice communication on cell phones is permitted only in the following locations:

- **Inside your car in the parking lot**
- **In the upstairs clubhouse guest rooms or on the Cottage grounds**
- **On the north side of the Clubhouse porch, facing the 16th tee**

While music has become more common on golf courses, music is not permitted anywhere on Secession Club grounds.

ATTIRE

Golfers must dress in a manner consistent with the traditions of the game. Shirts with collars are required and must be tucked in at all times. Shorts are permitted but must be within three inches of the knee; cargo shorts are not acceptable.

The following attire is not permitted anywhere on Secession Club property: Tank tops, Tennis shorts, T-shirts, Flip-flops, Jeans or denim of any kind or color, Cut-offs, Tennis-length skirts. Members and guests arriving on Club property in attire that does not meet the dress code must change immediately. No service will be provided until proper attire is worn. Bare feet are not permitted in public areas of the Clubhouse or on the adjacent porch.

Hats should be removed upon entering the Clubhouse.

CONDUCT AND DECORUM

The conduct of members and guests must reflect the traditions and spirit of the game of golf. The guidance above is intended to ensure an exceptional Secession experience. Unacceptable behavior includes, but is not limited to:

- **Any action that negatively impacts another member's or guest's experience**
- **Any behavior that could harm the Club's reputation in the community**
- **Any behavior that puts people or property at risk**
